### **Chita LNG Joint Terminal (co-owned by JERA and Toho Gas)**

Site area: 147,283m<sup>2</sup>

Receiving facilities: 1 berth (L1)

Storage facilities: 4 aboveground tanks (300,000m<sup>3</sup>)

Commercial operation: 1977

### **Chita L.N.G. Co., Ltd. Chita LNG Terminal (co-funded by JERA and Toho Gas)**

Site area: 319,640m<sup>2</sup>

Receiving facilities: 1 berth (L2)

Storage facilities: 6 aboveground tanks (480,000m<sup>3</sup>); 1 underground tank (160,000m<sup>3</sup>)

Commercial operation: 1983

### **Chita Midorihama Works (owned by Toho Gas)**

Site area: 302,461m<sup>2</sup>

Storage facilities: 3 underground tanks (620,000m<sup>3</sup>)

Commercial operation: 2001
