Contract structure	A four-company joint venture (“JV”) was established with TEPCO PG as representative and TEPCO, JERA, and TEPSCO as members; this JV concluded an agreement with JICA.
Roles of the four companies	<p>The four companies will cooperate closely and play the following main roles:</p> <p>TEPCO PG:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Project supervisor (JV representative) · Survey and study of power development and demand assumptions <p>TEPCO:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Survey and study of energy policies, regulations, and economic and financial matters related to decarbonization · Project administration and operational support <p>JERA:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Assistant project supervisor · Survey and study of low-carbon and decarbonized thermal power technologies, renewable energy, etc. <p>TEPSCO:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Survey and study of transmission system planning and operation · Support for local operations by its Jakarta office
